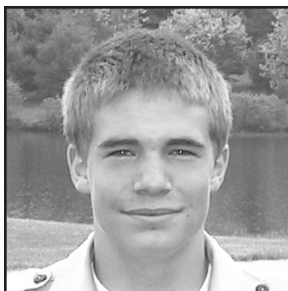




Chief's Bonnet

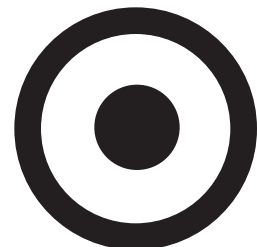
